Noah Franche-Nolan is inviting anyone who likes to sing, whether or not you are a member at St. John's. Every one to two months we will be preparing two songs, selected from traditional Christian, modern Christian or secular music with a spiritual theme.

If you would like to join the choir, all you need is

- A microphone (either a headset mic or a USB mic)
- Headphones
- A computer with a Digital Audio Workstation (DAW) Software. [PC users can download Reaper as their DAW for free, and Mac users can use Garage Band for free.]

Here's how it works:

- Noah will send you the sheet music and recorded piano parts (with vocal cues added on top) in advance.
- He will host a Zoom meeting to answer any questions about the music or the recording process two weeks before the deadline for your recorded music.
- You will record your track over top of his piano part and send him your individual track once it is complete. You can send the track via a cloud storage service such as Wetransfer, GoogleDrive, Dropbox or iCloud.

If technological access may be an issue, the Church may be able to help you out.
